Characteristics of a Well- Stated Objective



- 1. Performance - says what a learner is expected to be able to do
- 2. Conditions - describes the important conditions under which the performance is to occur
- 3. Criterion - describes the criterion of acceptable performance

A Well-stated Objective provides an appropriate basis for

- 1. Selecting content, method, and materials
- 2. Evaluating student achievement, and
- 3. Organizing the student's own time and efforts.

The Missing Link



- 1. Between objective statements and learning activities or course requirements
- 2. Between objective statements and course evaluation or testing/grading procedures
